**HPV:** Human Papilloma Virus, the HPV4 & HPV9 vaccines are given.

**Influenza:** The Flu vaccine is given, either injected or inhaled.

**MMR:** The Measles, Mumps, and Rubella vaccines are given.

**Pneumococcal Disease:** The PPSV23 and PCV13 vaccines are given.

**Tdap:** The Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis vaccines are given.

**Td:** The Tetanus and Diphtheria vaccines are given.

**Varicella Zoster:** The Shingles vaccine is given.
