2ND SATURDAYS FROM APRIL THROUGH OCTOBER, 2017
CRAFT VENDORS RULES AND REGULATIONS
Written 2/10/2016

- 1. All craft vendors must comply with and abide by Winnsboro Farmers' Market Rules and Regulations.**
- 2. Crafts will be allowed on the 2nd Saturday of months April through October.**
- 3. Crafters who are registered and approved will be able to sell at the Monday Night Live event at no cost; however, they must notify the Main Street Manager or Farmers' Market manager one week in advance. Monday Night Live is held on the 3rd Monday of March, April, May, June, September, October, and November.**

Specific Craft Criteria

For the purpose of the 2nd Saturday of the Winnsboro Farmers' Market crafts shall meet the following criteria:

1. All crafts must be hand made by the vendor; no re-selling is allowed.
2. Crafts must be the product of a home/cottage type industry rather than an industrial type production. To be considered "hand crafted", the item must show evidence of manual skills.
 - a. Examples of unacceptable items would be, but not limited to: tracings or paint by number, photographs, postcards, prints, printed materials, ceramics or pottery from commercial molds, wood carvings using duplicating machines, kits in any form, and any other items which clearly do not reflect originality of design.

- b. Upscaled and recycled craft products must meet the same criteria for quality design and workmanship.
- 3. No mechanical, optical, digital or electronic reproductions will be allowed.
- 4. All crafts must be of excellent workmanship both in quality and design
- 5. All craft vendor's products will be juried by the Winnsboro Farmers' Market Board
- 6. The Market Manager has the discretion to immediately remove any craft item that he/she considers objectionable and not qualifying.
