As you evaluate your giving, Fr. Don suggests the **5 - 1 - 4** process as written in the "Send Us As Stewards" pamphlet:

**5%** of your gross annual income to the Parish,

**1%** to the Diocese of Salina, and

**4%** to other charities (Catholic schools, missions, the poor, etc.)



Recent studies show that Catholics give between 1.1% and 1.4%. If you would prayerfully consider increasing your giving by 1% annually until you reach the **5-1-4** level in the future. When making a commitment to Sacrificial Giving, we place our trust and security in the Lord.

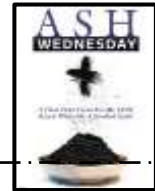

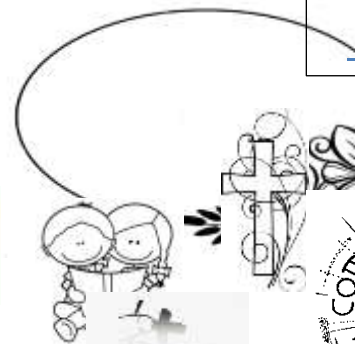

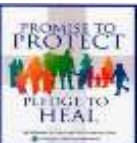
