Pentwater Sportfishing Association Update

PSA officers are staying connected via phone conferences and are making plans for post–lockdown activities....

- ⇒ The Big Fish contest will start on schedule, May 23.
- ⇒ The Memorial Derby will be postponed to a later date, still to be determined. Prizes will be of a different sort, with more cash prizes and gift certificates than physical prizes.
- ⇒ The annual raffle will still take place, as soon as there is a better feel for 'return to normalcy'.
- ⇒ The scheduled May 16th business meeting may or may not happen, depending on if Village buildings are open or not.
- ⇒ Except for fitting the postponed Derby into a new time slot, we hope to keep the calendar of events intact. Changes will be communicated via the newsletter and on the website. Right now, the only changes, although noteworthy, are through May.
- ⇒ Channel light installation is on hold until the fixtures can be re-engineered for high water and until people can get out to do it. The PSA is very conscious of a need for a navigation light on the North Pier at the entrance of the harbor.



On a lighter note, the DNR is planning on planting approximately 7000 steelhead fingerlings into the Pentwater River this year.

Early Spring fishing in the Southern sections of Lake Michigan did not happen in April as in previous years, so our population of Cohos and Kings in the Pentwater region might very well be slightly higher this year.
