The Shopko store located in Two Harbors is planning to close its doors permanently by mid-June. The closing could happen sooner if current inventory sells out before that date.

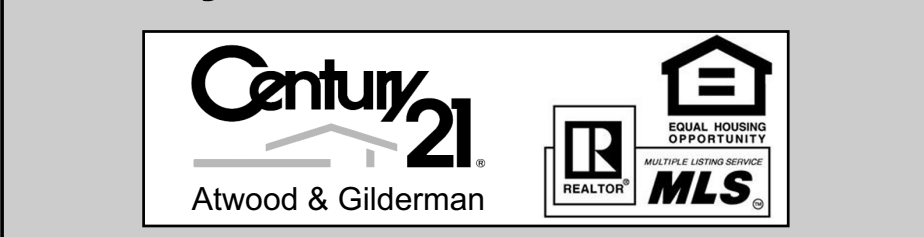
Shopko stores throughout the region will be closing around the same time, including stores in Duluth, Ely, Aitkin, and Moose Lake.

Despite an announcement by the company in January that the corporation was filing for Chapter 11 bankruptcy status and closing over 100 of their stores around the country, these local stores and about 250 more in other areas, were supposed to stay open.

Shopko had said that the bankruptcy was a way to begin restructuring to improve their finances. However, company officials now say that no buyer for the corporation has been found and they have made the decision to liquidate.
