JKLM ENERGY PROJECT UPDATE, SEPTEMBER 27

### ***No Isopropanol Present in Total of 19 Samples Analyzed to Date; Community Field Office to Open to the Public on September 28***

WEXFORD, Pa. (Sept. 27) – JKLM Energy, LLC issued the following update to the public regarding the company's continuing response to the release of drilling chemicals at its Sweden Township, Potter County wellpad. These updates and related information are available at a project-specific website:

As of September 26, 2015, JKLM Energy, LLC has received a total of 24 lab results from water sources near the Reese Hollow 118 wellpad. Isopropanol, the chemical of principal concern in regard to the release from the drill site, has been detected in only one water well, with a total of five wells confirmed with levels of methylene blue activated substances (MBAS), which are used to test for the presence of surfactants.

Preliminary results from the nearby Hershey Pond were also received and indicate the presence of MBAS, consistent with the foamy water conditions observed in the pond. Full analytical results of samples collected from the pond are expected on September 28 and JKLM will update the public accordingly.

JKLM also announced plans to open a community field office in Coudersport, which will be staffed from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The public is invited to visit the office to talk with project managers, and view maps and related information about the company's response efforts. The office will open on Monday, September 28, and is located at 200 N. West St. in Coudersport.

JKLM is continuing to work closely with local officials as well as the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to limit the release's impact to the community and restore the local water aquifer to pre-drilling quality.
