



## Greenport NY

Out on the North Fork of Long Island sits the small town of Greenport; original home to the Greenport Harbor Brewing Co. They are housed in the old firehouse situated off the main drag through town and right next door sits the old jail.

They also have a new facility about 8 miles west on RT 25 in Peconic, NY. This is their new home for bottling. Both places have tasting rooms, check them both out. On the particular Saturday that I was there, a food truck was also on site.

This area is also home to a number of wineries, more than I can count; so if your significant other or you for that matter are more into the grape version of an adult beverage, then they will not be disappointed. I have included the link for a listing of the wineries.

Now it is time to get to the important thing, the ride. You will head in a counterclockwise direction. The short ride is 30 miles long and flat. The ride passes along the shore line of Long Island Sound. On a clear day Connecticut is visible to the north across the sound. About 6 miles into the ride you will come to the Horton Point Lighthouse.

Continuing on you will ride past beach homes, sod farms, vegetable farms and grape vines; a lot of grape vines. The halfway point of the ride will take you into Mattituck. If you need to stop for a drink or food turn right on RT 25 W to take you into town, if you continue on the ride you will come to food and water about the 20 mile mark. When you get on RT 25 E you will have a good shoulder to ride on, just keep your head on a swivel when going through the small towns.

When you are heading back to Greenport you will pass by the Peconic facility of Greenport Harbor Brewing. If you are interested in adding about 20 miles to your ride, you can continue east on RT25 and head out to Orient Point. There is a small food shack at the ferry entrance. When done turn around and retrace your route back to Greenport. Just a side note; should you want to do the extra miles you may want to knock out this portion of the ride first. There is a nice shoulder to ride on, but the traffic to and from the ferry can be quite busy at times.
