

ALTON CHAMBERS

1918 - 1996

Alton Chambers, 78 of Southgate, a Sebawang High School graduate and later resident of Bad Axe, died Tuesday, Jan. 30, in U of M Medical Center, Ann Arbor.

He was born in Caro on Jan. 4, 1918, a son of Judson and Sarah (Kelly) Chambers. The family resided in Sebawang for several years and Mr. Chambers was graduated from SHS in 1937. He served in World War II with the U.S. Navy in the Pacific Theater and was later employed with Chrysler Corp. in Warren. He was a former member of First United Methodist Church of Bad Axe.

Surviving are two sons, Wayne Chambers and his wife, Demayanti of Grosse Ile, and Gene Kelly Chambers of Ohio, one daughter, Joann Marie Luack of Wilmington, DE, one granddaughter, three great-grandchildren, two brothers, Alger "Bud" Chambers and his wife of Waterford and Orville Chambers of Bad Axe.

One son, Lyta, preceded his father in death.

The funeral was held Saturday, Feb. 3, in MacAlpine Funeral Home, Bad Axe, with
