Garbage

Garbage is picked up TWICE A WEEK on WEDNESDAYS and FRIDAYS.

- Garbage must be bagged and placed in bin provided, any loose garbage is NOT the responsibility of the waste collector.
- Any bags over 30lbs will not be picked up.

Recycle

If you're unsure what is allowed in the recycle bins, please pick up a brochure at the office.

The recycle bins are a benefit to the community however, in order to be cost effective we need the cooperation of all individuals.

- Although the service is provided, we encourage the homeowners to take their own recyclables to the bins provided at the Co-op.
- **There is still too much recyclables being put into the garbage!**
- No recyclables in black garbage bags, clear only (do not tie bags, dump them and reuse the bag).
- Recyclable food containers must be cleaned, paper products do not include used tissues or soiled paper towels.
- No contaminated recyclables of any kind and absolutely no Styrofoam.

Dogs

This is an age old problem that everyone could fix by just limiting yourself to how many dogs you own, be responsible and respectful enough to others by containing them to your own property.
