## INFORMATION & GUIDELINES FOR 2018 DOWNTOWN MOUNT AIRY FALL ART WALK

- Businesses are encouraged to allow artists to sell their work and allow the artists to keep 100% of the profits.
- Most of the artists will have their own display equipment. Artists should contact the business owner/venue about display arrangements.
- There is NO cost to businesses to participate and there is NO cost to artists to participate. The goal is to provide an arts event that benefits downtown and local artists.
- Light refreshments may be served on Saturday. It is recommended that this be minimal and that cost be kept to a minimum.
- Entertainment may be provided but it is preferred that the “artist” be the entertainment. Potters may have their equipment on site, quilters can be quilting, basket makers can be making baskets, etc.
