
SPRING TOUR – MARIETTA, OHIO May 12-14, 2023

{Modeled after the memorable Pittsburgh Fall Tour of 2021, which featured an all-day cruise on the Monongahela River}


Cruise the Muskingum River Canal on the sternwheeler Valley Gem

- Saturday May 13, 9:00-5:00, with catered breakfast and lunch;
- Two-way transits of two historic hand-cranked canal locks;
- Valley Gem (constructed 1988-9) is authentically propelled by paddlewheel;
- Spectacular views of industrial, residential, agricultural and natural areas;
- Enclosed lower deck and restrooms are wheelchair accessible and climate controlled;
- Open-air upper deck is partially covered and reachable only by stairs;
- PRICE \$78 per person, for this 8-hour trip including two complete meals.

Thursday May 11, 6:00-8:00, Informal Meet-up

If you'll be in Marietta on Thursday May 11, then join us for an informal riverside gathering at Boathouse BBQ (buy-your-own food & drink). NO CHARGE but mark the Registration Form so we can plan and keep you updated.

Friday May 12, 9:00-4:30, Industrial Tours

Gather for breakfast at Wendy's, then carpool to guided tours of nearby factories, such as Sewah Studios, America's leading producer of cast aluminum historical markers. NO CHARGE but buy-your-own breakfast and lunch. There is a maximum number allowed, so please only mark the Registration Form if you actually plan to attend.

Friday May 12, 6:00-8:00, Banquet at the historic Betsey Mills Club

- Enjoy a complete hot buffet with meat and vegetarian options.

OPTIONS FOR MOTHER'S DAY, SUNDAY MAY 14

Sunday May 14, 10:00-noon, your choice of two planned morning activities EITHER

 A guided 10-mile bicycle tour on the west bank of the Muskingum River, following the route of Saturday's cruise. Bring your own bike, or make sure you rent <u>IN ADVANCE</u>. (The Hackett Hotel in downtown Marietta <u>may</u> offer free bike rental to guests.)

OR

 A guided walking tour of Marietta's famous Mound Cemetery (where more Revolutionary War officers are buried than in any other cemetery anywhere), and several other nearby mounds from two different ancient mound-building cultures.



FOR THE REST OF THE DAY, ON YOUR OWN

- Canal enthusiasts may want to visit Roscoe Village, less than 90 minutes north via I-77.
- Or, Marietta has THREE great historical museums within easy walking distance:
 Campus Martius Museum, Ohio River Museum and the Castle Historic House.
