

# The Stickman Mahogany Chest

Though not technically a puzzle box, this one of a kind Mahogany Chest does not lack in factors of awe and delivers on every level. This was Robert's first and only attempt at puzzle furniture. Made from scraps of mahogany pillaged from a carpentry shop trash bin, this chest contains a total of 4 drawers (two of which are hidden), 9 compartments, and a three-sectioned top tray that slides from side to side within the chest. Two of its compartments are hidden and cannot be accessed until the secret drawers are first discovered and opened.



The lid of this chest is a patchwork of



intricately cut tongue in groove mahogany pieces of varying hues that interlock to sturdily produce its mosaic lid. It has hand carved decorative corners, and uniquely designed solid wood levers on each side keep the lid from opening too far.

Originally, this chest was listed for \$1200 at craft stores and e-bay, but remained unsold for over a year. The original Stickman instruction flyer and price tag from that era are left attached to the inside of the lid for nostalgia. Robert eventually resigned this piece to his personal collection and now uses it to store past Stickman puzzles.
