In light of this ongoing pandemic and the restrictions in place by MDHHS, the Township will be offering a one-time drop off at the transfer station on US2 **beginning Wednesday, September 22, 2021 through Friday, September 30, 2021** that will be available to verified Ironwood Township residents only, paid for by the Township.

The drop off will be for items such as furniture, garbage, etc. Like a regular spring/fall clean-up day!

Items listed below will be turned away, unless residents will be willing to pay a **self-pay separate charge** for these items. Charges are listed below.

Items will need to be sorted into separate piles and deposited in the correct bins as follows;

- Televisions or Computer Monitors \$10 each, plus the weight (other parts okay)
- Refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air-conditioners \$20 each
- Mattresses and box springs \$18 each, plus the weight
- Car/Light truck and small vehicle tires \$4 each and an additional \$1, if it is on a rim
- Larger tires are anywhere from \$15 each to \$75, depending on if the type of tire, Ex. Truck, loader, semi, etc. tire

The site will be open 8:30 am to 4:00 pm Monday through Friday and access will be one vehicle at a time. This letter will be required as "payment" for showing your township resident status as well as name and parcel/house address to be verified at the transfer station for "payment".
