Skill level required: All skill levels and ages welcome!

Supplies:

- 3 4mm stone or crystal bead
- 20 feet 24 gauge wire
- fine gauge chain

Tools:

- chain nose pliers
- jig (I will supply these)
- wire cutter
- 6 inch ruler or measuring tape

Time required for class: 3 hours – project will not be completed during class but will be easily completed outside of class.
