Free Covid Booster Shots in Silver Bay

The ever present coronavirus is still spreading among our communities and affecting our most vulnerable populations of loved ones. Not only are many people still at a high risk of serious illness/death, but it's also incredibly inconvenient for any of us to get sick and have to put everything in our lives on hold while we recover.

The holidays are coming up quickly. As we prepare to come in from the outdoors and gather together once again to share the warmth of our home cooked meals, stories and laughs, it's a good time to start thinking about receiving your booster shot against the most recent covid variants that are currently out and about to protect yourself and friends and family.

The Silver Bay EssentiaHealth Pharmacy is now administering free walk-in booster shots to anyone who would like one, with or without insurance. The pharmacy began administering the most recent booster September 1st, and has since vaccinated over 400 people. EssentiaHealth will "vaccinate anyone, any day we are open, who are over the age of 12," says pharmacist Jake Keller. People under the age of 12 can find health care providers to administer the booster vaccine at Lake View Clinic in Two Harbors or at a clinic in Duluth. To schedule an appointment in Duluth, call 218-249-4200.

Bivalent is given as a single booster dose at least 2 months after the primary vaccine or most recent booster dose. The booster is able to be mixed and matched with other companies' vaccines, such as Moderna and others. The FDA has authorized Pfixer-BioNTech covid-19 vaccine bivalent booster to provide

better protection against the omicron variant. EssentiaHealth is open Monday through Friday from 8:30am-5:00m. They take their last vaccination at 4:30pm. The pharmacy is closed Saturdays and Sundays. They are located at 99 Edison Blvd., Silver Bay in the Mary Mac Building. Upon walking in, there is a short form to fill out, followed by a short wait, and an even shorter visit with the pharmacist to receive the booster.

Remember to bring your vaccination card with you to keep track of your vaccine records. This card is also important to have with you when traveling for the holidays.
