Continuing from last month: The Knights are an example of community. The Mass is the focus of the community, the supreme act of Faith and Worship. We gather each week summoned by Jesus at Mass. We first process in led by the Cross of Christ and the Gospels. Beginning with the Introductory Rites: Greeting: In the Name of the Father and the Son: Amen. 'The Lord be with you. 'And with Your Spirit', Penitential Rite: the Kyrie; Lord have Mercy and Christ have Mercy. The priest finishes with the Collect, the prayer to prepare us for the Liturgy of the Word and Eucharist. The Old Testament, the Psalm, the Epistle. Then the Gospel, Listening we hear how the first reading is related to the Gospel. Following the Gospel the priest expounds on the Scripture as it relates to our lives. Finding a word we can use in our daily lives. The Creed follows: I believe. Universal Prayer follows with particular intentions. Then the Eucharist with the presentation and preparation of the gifts of wine and bread. Cantor sings a hymn during the preparation. Priest says: Pray Brethren...; people respond with 'May the Lord accept...'. Then priest prays the Prayer over the Offerings the people respond with 'Amen'. The Priest now begins the Eucharist Prayer with Preface which begins: 'The Lord be with you' the people respond with: 'And with your Spirit'. Following this introduction; the priest begins the Eucharistic Prayer: I or II or III or IV. To be continued

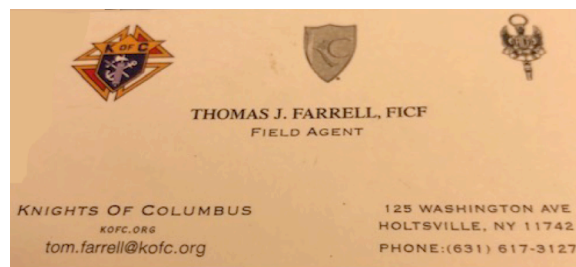
