3. Receipts are lower by £5,679

In the previous financial year there was a larger than usual VAT reclaim of £5,367.83, as opposed to £1,983.77 received this year.

There have been no CIL monies this year, whereas in 21/22 £5,234.50 was received. However these decreases are offset by grant monies of £3,400 being received this year whereas none were received last year.

6. Costs are lower by £957

The two main factors affecting this are:

- a) that £5591.70 was spend on traffic calming last year whilst the traffic calming grant received during this year is ringfenced and not yet spent,
- b) offset by more being spent on footpaths this year (£4,212.00) compared to last year (£1,453.09), and a larger spend on grass cutting, equipment and repairs this year (£2,198.31) compared to last year (£188.62). These figures are summarised in the table below.

7/8. Cash and Investments/Balance forward higher by £3,784

As explained above for Box 6 there has been lower expenditure during 22/23 than in the previous financial year. This, together with £2,000 of ringfenced grant monies received for a traffic calming project means that our balance carried forward is larger.
