Hi Everyone....

Been a long, busy day and ready for the weekend. Hope you have a GREAT game tonight and able to relax a bit this weekend. Spend a little time with your family also....

Today's tip.....the hardest call in the book.....traveling. This one is a classic incorrect ravel call most likely because it LOOKS weird. Take a look at the clip <u>here</u>.

The pivot foot is *most likely* the left foot, but I would contend that the T wasn't able to clearly see that from where he was and where the ball was located when he picked it up. SO, let's agree the pivot foot WAS his left foot (which would be the most restrictive for him). He picked the pivot foot up to make a pass but never got the chance to even complete the pass OR put the pivot foot back down since the whistle had blown. Since he never put the pivot foot back down, not travel. In addition, he is permitted to lift the pivot foot to pass or shoot......

This one LOOKED weird, but it was not a violation.

See the WHOLE play, have a PATIENT whistle and be POSITIVE when you put air in the whistle!
