EGS Gymnastics will be hosting the 4th annual Anti-Bullying Invitational! This gymnastic competition has gymnasts invited from over 15 states in the US. This is a USAG Sanctioned competition with gymnasts age 5-17 levels 2-10 and Xcel all levels. The goal of this meet is to raise more awareness of bullying and encourage everyone to take a stand against bullying. Last year we already have over 400 gymnasts registered to compete! We are excited to announce we will be hosting our event at the **Carroll County Ag Center** (706 Agricultural Center Dr, Westminster md 21157) again for our 2019 meet! Check out the pictures on our website! The place is fabulous we can't wait to see everyone there this January 2019! We are working on some great Guest Speakers and of course some fabulous vendors. It's going to be even BIGGER and if possible more fun in 2019! Expected traffic over the 3 days is over 2000 people. We are scheduled to host 16 sessions over 3 days each session runs anywhere from 1.5 - 4 hours so the spectators are constantly changing.

Sponsorship opportunities are also available to our vendors if interested let us know. There are options to add coupons or promotional items to the tote bags that we will be handing out with paid admission to the event. All spectators pay an admission fee to this event.

Booth Agreement - Rules and Regulations

- EGS & EGSPA Anti-Bully Invitational volunteers and staff will not be liable for damage to property of vendors, or their employees or assigns, or to their persons, due to fire, robbery, accidents, acts of God, or any cause whatsoever that may arise from use and occupancy of booth and grounds. The vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the EGS & EGSPA staff for any damages incurred. It is the responsibility of the vendor to obtain insurance coverage on property brought onto the premises of the Carroll County Ag Center. Vendor assumes full responsibility of items left in the booths
- Telephone, Internet, water, electrical and drain service will not be provided to the individual. Electric can be supplied on a first received vendor form request at an additional charge. Electrical service may be purchased from the Alamo Classic for an additional \$40 for the weekend
- EGS Anti-Bullying Invitational Committee reserves the right to reject or remove from the sale any items that are unsuitable for a family-oriented festival, i.e., items that are controversial, may be offensive, or have legality issues, etc.
- Booth set-up will be in two areas.
 - 1) along the center between the gymnastic competition areas
 - 2) along the outer walls beside the gymnastic competition areas
- Vendors must provide their own display props such as tables, shelves, chairs, etc. (table and 2 chairs will be provided if vendor paid for them to be included)
- All items for sale must be displayed within your booth space, keeping walkways clear. Vendors will be notified of the times for set up.
All displays must be free standing. Nothing may attach to walls or columns of the Ag Center by any means at all.
- Consumption, use, or sale of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, pornography, fireworks, smoke and stink bombs, or illegal drugs is strictly forbidden.
- Food Vendors are responsible for obtaining the necessary and appropriate food permits from the appropriate agencies.
- The primary vendor registering for the booth space must be **at least 18** years old and is responsible for the items and assistant vendors within booth space. Booths must be staffed at all times during the competition the vendor or its representatives.
- Full payment in must be received in advance. Booth locations will be assigned by EGSPA event coordinator based on date received.
- Vendors are responsible for keeping their booth area clean. All items related to the booth, including trash, packing materials, etc., must be removed by the vendor when the booth closes down. Vendors are expected to remain open during the entire competition times on both days.
- Vendors and their personnel will be expected to maintain a business-like attitude.
