

2017 Yuengling Golden Tee League

Timeline

League will consist of 2 segments plus a Final Tournament for qualified players
Segment 1 – May 29 through July 9
Off Week – July 10 through July 16
Segment 2 – July 17 through August 27

Format

Each Monday, a pre-determined course will be selected as the “Course of the Week”. You may play this course as many times as you wish, but only your best score will count toward the final standings. At the end of each week, your best score will be locked in with your final score of each segment being the total score of each of the six week’s qualifying scores. Ties will be broken using Great Shot Points. Each completed round played by registered players on the “Course of the Week” receives an entry in a drawing for a \$100 Golden Tee gift card.

Prizes

First through third place of each segment qualify for the end of season Tournament to be held September 12. Once qualified for the tournament, a player is not eligible to win another segment.

Registration

Entry is \$20 per segment
Players receive a \$20 Golden Tee gift card with registration.
Players may register with PayPal at www.amusement.com.
All registrations must be completed by June 26. Players that register after the beginning of the league may retroactively play all previous courses but will be ineligible for any previous prizes. League officials with A&M Amusement will handle make up dates on a case by case basis.

Tournament

Six qualified league players will compete for three spots in the Golden Tee Tournament of Champions to be held in Kansas City, Missouri on October 13-15, 2017. Players with a handicap of -24 or higher will be considered a master player and be paired with a non-master player. Players with a handicap of -23 or below will be considered a non-master player and be paired with a master player.

Doubles & Singles Events

General Info

2018 courses will be used for the tournaments.

Entry

- Must have a TOC 9 pass, which includes entry for 1 Doubles Team (includes two competitors)
- Must complete at least 200 18-hole games on a Club Lucky GT between Jan 1 – Sep 30, 2017.
- Only 1 Master Level Player per Team.
- Players with a handicap of -24 or better are considered Masters.
- We reserve the right to make any player a Master based upon known ability.
- Each player must compete in both the Doubles event and Singles event.

Doubles Tournament

- \$10k minimum prize pool
- Seeding determined by random draw
- 1 Master Level Player allowed per team.
- Play your own score. Team score is gross of both players.
- Tiebreaker is GSPs

Doubles FAQs

How do I find a partner?

You can team up with another GT player who has completed at least 200 games on Club Lucky GT's between Jan 1 and Sep 30, 2017. Only 1 Master Level Player per team. If you need a partner to make up a team, contact us and we'll connect you with someone.

In what format will the Doubles event be run?

Play your own ball. Doubles teams will play in a foursome. Scores for each doubles team will be added together. Best team score wins. In the case of a tie, the foursome will play 9 holes more. If there is another tie, they will play sudden death.

Singles Tournament

- \$30k minimum prize pool
- Gold and Purple Brackets
- 5 Course Qualifier
- Double Elimination
