At the April 1st Membership Meeting, the a motion to renovate and expand the Tiki Bar Deck and seating area with the cost not exceed \$15,000 from the general fund was voted on and approved. This will be completed in time for the Tiki Bar opening!

The Bylaws Committee will be discussing the recommended changes and updates to the bylaws at the May 6th Membership Meeting with hopes to vote on these changes at the June 3rd Membership meeting. You should have received an email with the recommendations and copies are also available at the bar.

At the May 6th Membership meeting the board will be recommending and discussing a drainage system to be installed at a cost of \$35,000 and to replace the current driveway with a wider driveway at a cost of \$33,000
