<u>Second Lesson</u> 1 John 2:15-17 <u>15</u> Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <u>16</u> For all that is in the world--the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride in possessions--is not from the Father but is from the world. <u>17</u> And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.
