1889	Mr Ward of Wimpole Street agreed to sell 8½ acres of land, for £6260, at Eastney to be used as an extension to the cemetery to be transferred on 24/6/1896. The home office objected to the extension and the Town Council attempted to pay compensation for non-completion and purchase land to the south instead. Mr Ward did not agree.	95
19 August 1896	Mr Ward, solicitors Messrs Cousins & Burbidge demanded to see the books of Portsmouth Burial Board	95
1898	Mr Wards case dismissed with costs, but appeal started	95
1898	Mr Wards appeal successful	95
1898	6½ acres to south offered in place of 8¼ acres to east, offer declined	95
