

WALTER REINHARDT CLABUESCH

1906-1990

Walter Reinhardt Clabuesch, age 83, a former Pigeon resident, passed away Thursday, May 10 at Valley Grand Manor in Brownsville, Texas.

He was born Aug. 17, 1906 in Pigeon, son of the late Frederick and Hulda (Beyer) Clabuesch. He was united in marriage to Jewel T. Pinkston on Aug. 30, 1936.

Mr. Clabuesch was a 1929 graduate of Coyne Electrical School of Chicago, a State of Michigan certified Master Electrician and owner of Clabuesch Electric for 41 years until his retirement in 1971. He was a former member of the Pigeon Rotary Club, the Scenic Golf and Country Club, the Pigeon Fire Department and the Pigeon Village Council.
