He later told members that the County plans to remove Napoleon Broward's statute from the courthouse. While Governor Broward is credited for draining the Everglades, which resulted in an increase in livable land in the area, he was also a vocal segregationist. He advocated the removal of blacks from the United States. Commissioner Bogen asked members for their points of view on the removal of the statue and whether the county should change its name. Members had differing points of view.
