LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

- I, Lester G. Taylor, Jr., a legal resident of Kansas City, Missouri, now in the active military service as a Captain, ASN 0-25618, in the Army of the United States, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument to be my IAST WILL AND TESTA MENT, in manner following, that is to say:
- l. I hereby cancel, annul and revoke all wills and codicils by me at any time heretofore made;
- 2. I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Genevieve J. Taylor, now residing in Elizabeth, New Jersey, all my estate and all of the property of which I may die seized and possessed and to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, of whatsoever kind and nature, and wheresoever it may be situated, be it real, personal or mixed, absolutely and forever; PROVIDED HOWEVER, should my said wife predecease me, then and in that event, I give, devise and bequeath my estate, as aforesaid, unto our child which is expected to be born after the execution of this WILL.

In the event that my wife survives me, I give and bequeath unto our child, expected to be born after the Execution of this WILL, the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, knowing full well that such child will be properly cared for, and I direct that this WILL remain valid and effective despite the birth of such child;
- 4. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Genevieve J. Taylor of Elizabeth, New Jersey as Executrix of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and direct that she be permitted to serve without bond or surety;
- 5. I hereby authorize and empower my Executrix in her absolute discretion to sell, exchange, convey, transfer, assign, mortgage, lease, pledge, invest or reinvest the whole or any part of my real or personal estate, if such be necessary in the administration of my estate.
