

American Legion Baseball enjoys a reputation as one of the most successful and tradition-rich amateur athletic leagues. Each year young people, ages 13 to 19, participate. Since its inception in 1925, the league has had millions of players, including countless who have gone on to play in college and professional baseball, with 68 inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame.

Legion Baseball also has a reputation for serving the young people who play for it. The league annually awards tens of thousands of dollars in college scholarships to its players, and major league scouts regularly watch for Legion players with big-league aspirations.

American Legion Baseball does not require that its players be affiliated with the American Legion in any way except having a desire to play baseball.
