Mark 13:24-32

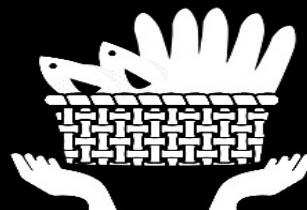
