ITALIAN COURSES:

INTRODUCTION TO ITALIAN

8-week session - \$95

Tuesday 5:00pm - 6:00pm

Instructor: Daniela Ciccone

This is an introductory course designed for people who have no prior knowledge of Italian.

Topics will include: pronunciation, greetings, days, dates, numbers, time, money, and expressing personal information.

This course does not require a textbook.

Class dates: March 12, 19, 26, April 2, 9, 23, 30, May 7 (No class on April 16th)

ITALIAN BEGINNER 1 8-week session - \$95 Tuesday 6:00pm - 7:00pm

Instructor: Daniela Ciccone

This course is designed for students who were enrolled in the Introduction to Italian course in Winter Session or anyone who has some knowledge of basic Italian and does not need an Introductory course.

Topics will include: food vocabulary (expressing likes and dislikes, describing foods, ordering food, etc.) and continued practice of basic grammar concepts in order to facilitate conversation.

This course does not require a textbook.

ITALIAN BEGINNER 2

8-week session - \$95

Tuesday 7:00pm - 8:00pm

This course is designed for students who were enrolled in the Beginner 1 course in Winter Session or anyone who has some knowledge of basic Italian grammar (i.e. present tense verbs).

Topics will include: clothing vocabulary (expressions and dialogues related to shopping in Italy, colors, demonstrative adjectives) and continued practice of present tense verbs in order to facilitate conversation.

This course does not require a textbook.

ITALIAN BEGINNER 3 8-week session - \$95 Wednesday 7:00pm - 8:00pm

This course is designed for students who were enrolled in the Beginner 2 course in Winter Session or anyone who has some knowledge of basic Italian grammar (i.e. present tense verbs).

Topics will include: family vocabulary, possessive adjectives, descriptive adjectives, and idiomatic expressions.

The class will be taught exclusively in Italian and students are expected to ask/answer all questions in Italian.

ITALIAN ADVANCED 1
