ELIGIBILITY:

UNDERGRADUATE

- Must be currently enrolled, full-time, in a construction-related degree program at a school in the United States
- Must have a current cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Must have at least one term remaining in a course of study leading to a degree.

CONSTRUCTION TRADES

- Must be currently enrolled in a construction-related training program which is approved by the Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, community college, technical school or equivalent.
- Must be obtaining training in a construction-related craft or trade.



REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants are responsible for ensuring that all items are emailed to the Foundation and received by February 28th.
 - See website for required forms for each Scholarship option as they vary.

AWARDS

- •/Winners are selected by the NAWIC Founders' Scholarship Foundation Awards Committee.
- Based on applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular activities, employment experience and financial need.
- Will be notified of their awards no later than June 15th.
- Proof of matriculation for the next school term (and any other NFSF requirements) must be received by July 15th.
- Checks are sent directly to the school no later than August preceding the school year.
