FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Welcome to Immanuel Baptist Church. It is always my pleasure to present our newest members in this article each week. Join me in welcoming Dick & Lorrie White to the IBC family. Please make it a point to welcome them.

If you are visiting us for the first time today, we especially welcome you and our hope is that you enjoy the service. We also hope you will sense the presence of the Holy Spirit this morning. If you are looking for a church home, our prayer is that you seek His direction and guidance and for you to be sensitive to His leading, wherever that might lead you.

I will interrupt the series of messages from the Book of 1 John as we celebrate and observe the Lord's Supper this morning. This is one of two ordinances of the church which we observe, with the other being baptism. If you are not a member of IBC, know that we practice "open communion" which means you are welcome to join us provided you are a born-again believer in Jesus Christ as your Savior. Please help to make this a truly worshipful, meaningful time this morning.

This term "Lord's Supper" is used only in the Bible in 1 Corinthians 11:20. It is also known as Communion, the Lord's Table and the Eucharist, which actually is derived from a Greek word for "giving thanks." Its origin was on the night before Jesus died, at a meal commonly known as the Last Supper. Most likely this was the time of celebration of the Jewish Passover meal which God established in the days of Moses. But when Jesus said, "This is My body" and "This is My blood" while distributing the bread and the cup, He did something different. These are symbols of His body which was sacrificed, and His blood which was shed for each of us who accept Him as Savior. This is a time when we come before Him in unity with one another and in our loyalty to Christ.

This past week was a time of celebration for these United States of America. Please join me in continuing to pray for our country and our leaders. The only answer for us is Jesus.

It is an exciting time to be serving the Lord as He continues to bless us as only He can!
