

"There's Something About That Name"

"A good name is to be more desired than great wealth..." Proverbs 22:1

At our church business meeting last year we mentioned the possibility of changing the church's name. There did not appear to be any objection to that general idea. The elders have continued to consider that possibility. We have looked at what other churches have done with name changes, especially Baptist churches.

Our perception is that the name "Baptist" has more potential negatives than positives in terms of attracting people to our congregation. Denominational names and affiliations in recent years have had less ability to attract those in younger generations.

When I first came to Boulder City, our church was part of what was called the Southwest Conference of the Conservative Baptist Association. Our association has twice changed its name since then. Most recently it has adopted the name Venture Church Network. The theology of the association has not changed. But the association itself and many of our associated churches have recognized that there is more potential in reaching our communities by dropping the name "Baptist." Where once the name Baptist said something significant about a church's theology, today there are all kinds of churches, including many with a weak theology, who call themselves Baptists. Recently Hope Baptist in Boulder City dropped the name Baptist from its title.

We elders have no particular name in mind to suggest for a change. We could just drop the name Baptist and be Bethany Church. That would maintain the name recognition that we may already have in the community. The downside is that the name "Bethany" does not communicate much to unchurched people. Perhaps there is a more effective name that we could consider.

In consulting with other churches and pastors who have gone through the process, they have suggested that there is benefit in not choosing a name that is used by many other churches. According to church consultant Thom Ranier the most common new names adopted by churches in recent years include words such as journey, mosaic, foundry, bridge, generation, and cross (as in crossroads). There may be some benefit in connecting a name with a local physical location or with something of local historical significant. Perhaps there is a name which also has Biblical significance.

Pastor Steve Tomlinson was involved in changing his church's name from Manhasset Baptist Church to Shelter Rock Church. Shelter Rock was a physical rock in their location which had historical significance and also has Biblical connotations. It was also a unique name. He feels that the name change was a definite positive factor in attracting new people from his largely Catholic and Jewish area.

So we elders want to encourage you to think and pray about a possible name change for our church. Be creative. We have in mind that at our November business meeting that we will hand out cards and ask you to submit names that might be effective for our congregation. We will try to wittle the submissions down and present the most promising candidates for a vote at a later time.


