



Courageous Faith: Over the next few months, we will offer an online program called Courageous Faith. This program is from an online summit hosted by Convergence US, of The United Church of Christ, that helps congregations find ways to be church in our changing times. The summit was a virtual gathering of people of faith and moral conscience. We

purchased the ability to use this material after the summit is over so we will host 6 sessions online over the next 8 weeks. If you are interested in participating in this let <u>Russell know</u>. The sessions will include a video conversation with a prominent theologian/pastor/author on a particular topic related to Courageous Faith, followed by conversation among the group online. We will meet online Thursday evenings at 7pm.

Our hospitality activities will be restricted to 'take out' services.

- Coffee, tea and snacks will be shared in take out containers at the north door (facing Dewdney Avenue).
- Soup and bannock will be shared in take-out containers at the south door (from the main hall).
- Family Breakfast will be served in take out containers at the south door (from the main hall).

The restriction of service to take out means that a lower level of help is required for the hospitality, the Soup and Bannock and the Family Breakfast programs. (WE do not have to set up and take down tables and cutlery etc.) Therefore, at this time, we will not expect volunteers from our supporting churches. However, we continue to request your prayers and support. We will need ongoing encouragement and support to continue to provide the take out services.
