- 2) From East Orlando, take SR 417 (greenway) north to SR 434, left on 434 to US 17-92, then left 1/4 mile to Enzo's on the right. If you come to Dog Track Road, you've gone too far.
- 3) From Winter Park, take US 17-92 past Lee Road and SR 436, Enzo's is on the left, just past Dog Track Rd. (if you pass the Publix, you've gone too far)

Careful: *The restaurant sits back from road, sign next to road may be difficult to see!*

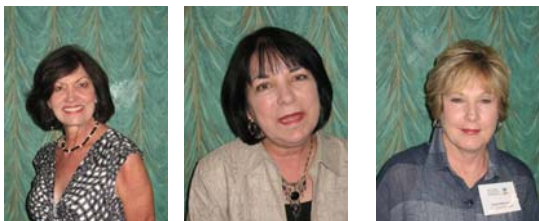

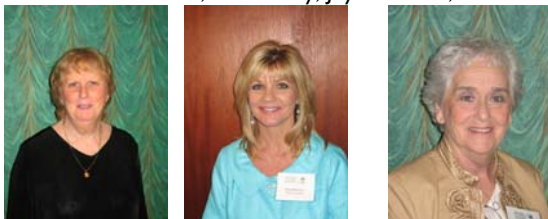
