

A small card that looks like a credit card and has pin connectors on one end. (I thought that it would look like an old computer deck card; you know -those stiff manila cards with all the holes in them) I am rather disappointed that it looks so compact. Three darts in the double bull in steel darts is a nearly impossible task. Three darts in the triple 20 is nearly impossible in electronic darts. Would not the person who studies and practices both steel and electronic have the advantage?

NEWS ITEMS

Lou Larson from Betson's Distributing was kind enough to explain to me the Pennsylvania Amusement & Music Machine's Association \$7500 Guaranteed Payback! Classified Dart Tournament occurring on 4-6 November 1994. The Classified Dart Tournament means that they are accepting your personal Super Spree, SPRE or APR to enter you into the division that most makes sense for your ability. Super Spree, SPRE, or APR are acronyms for various compilations of your averages done over the course of your English Mark Darts career. The vendors have this information and you should get it from them, because if you are not ranked in this manner you will be put in the A division, which is a shame if you are a C division player. They will have a list of names with the scores from the national network, but pre-registering will be

the quickest way to get into the tournaments. This system was used in New York State fairly successfully. This project should allow all types of players to compete on a more fair level of competition than at any time before.

The main computer then calls the dart machine up the next day to get the scores, thereby eliminating the need to keep paperwork on the scores and calling the league coordinator office. Three Rivers Electronic Darts Association* (TREDA) is also trying this new system for the scoring of team competition.

The game or to go first is chosen by the winner of the Diddle. The games of choice are 501, Cricket, and 301 (four players with freeze rule). There are slight variations of this wherever you go.

HOUND AND HARE

This is a game that is played on a steel board, although it could be played on the electronic boards with Count Up. Players diddle for middle (closest to the bull) to choose the "hare", who travels in a clockwise direction starting from the double 20, and moving one section at a time aiming at the doubles (1, 18, 4, 13) around the board. The "hound" starts from the triple 12, and moves in a clockwise direction hitting the triples to catch the "hare", by passing up the section that the "hare" has last hit. The players then switch, the "hare" becoming the "hound" and vice versa. A variation has the "hare" hitting a single and a double before moving on while the "hound" hits only doubles. Unless the "hare" returns to the 20, the winner is the "hare" who goes the furthest before being caught or who gets the furthest in 8 rounds. The game is also known as the Fox and the Hound.
