31 daily radiation treatments to brain and spine followed by 6 months of aggressive chemotherapy treatments...many blood and platelet transfusions...over 600 needle pokes to her body

had to face more aggressive radiation treatments.

Results of CyberKnife radiation treatment was a big success and Kelsey returned to grade 8 where she was elected student council president!

But unfortunately the tumour returned in Oct 2011 and no further treatment was possible. Before

Kelsey became an angel on December 13, 2011 she created Team Kelsey to raise awareness and fundraise for children affected by childhood cancer.
