


## At-Home Color Maintenance

## Touch-Up Kit

Your Semi-Custom Touch-Up Kit will help maintain your color on your hairline and down your part between appointments.

This simple color formulation is not your exact color formula. Chances are your stylist uses more than one tube of color in your salon formula.

So to keep things simple for you, your stylist will provide you with only one tube of color.

When used properly your tube of color should last around 6 months.

Your Touch-Up Kit is only to be used around your hairline and down your part for aesthetic purposes, until your next appointment.

If used improperly for long periods of time, this semi-custom color will leave color bands lighter than your actual salon color.

This improper use will result in your stylist performing a color-correction service on you to fix the color bands.

## What's In Your Kit

- 1) Non Latex Nitrile Gloves
- 2) Plastic Cap
- 3) Color Bowl and Color Brush
- 4) 2oz. Tube of Color
- **5)** 2oz. Color Developer
- 6) A Blending Color Comb
- **7)** A Single Sheet Of Touch-Up Kit Instructions With Your Stylist's Notes For You Should You Need Any

Your Touch-Up Kit comes in a convenient premium tote that you can store under the sink in your bathroom.

## **How To Use**

- 1) Be sure you have your gloves on to protect your hands
- 2) Mix  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz. of color and  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz of developer in your color bowl. Mix color and developer thoroughly with your color brush. Always color hair in the bathroom and watch for any drops on the floor or counter during the application process.
- 3) Make sure your hair is dry and styled to your preferred part.
- **4)** Apply your color on your part and hairline and press down to saturate all the hairs evenly.
- **5)** Use your comb to gently blend out your color about a half inch.
- **6)** Processing times range from 20-30 minutes. Test color development by gently scraping the color off of an application spot.
- 7) Clean up any color spots on the skin using a paper towel or cotton pad with soap and warm water.
- **8)** Once your color is processed, rinse color out very thoroughly, wash with shampoo, and apply your conditioner. You can do this at your kitchen sink or in your shower.
- 9) If you get a drop of toner in your eye, flush thoroughly with water.
- **10)** If you are a four week client, it is advisable to Touch-Up at two weeks. If you are a six week client, it is advisable to Touch-Up at three weeks.
