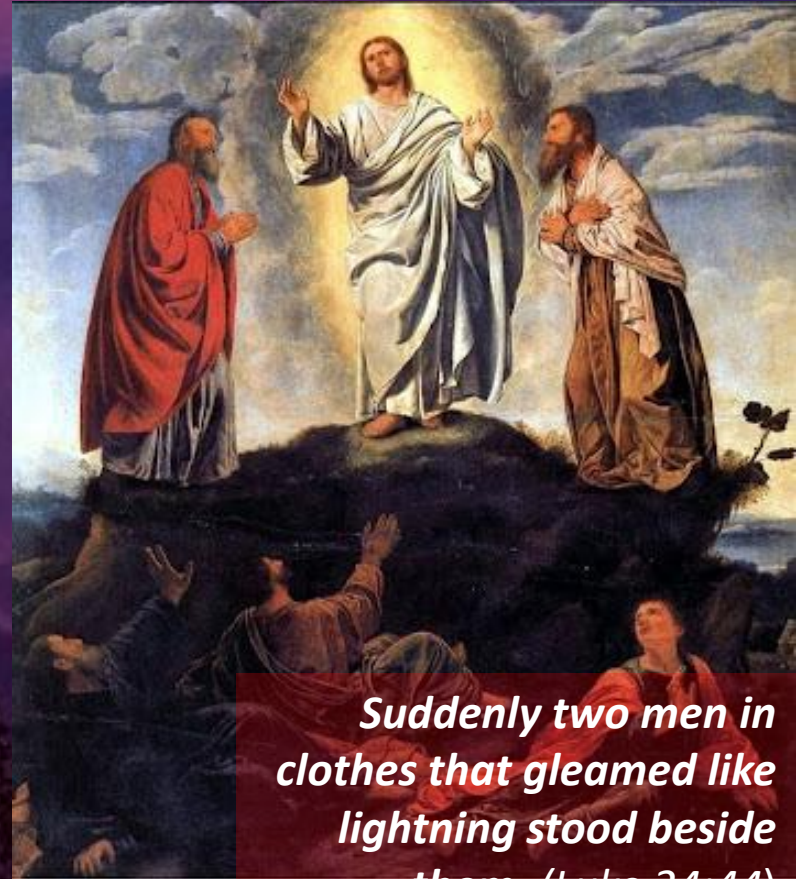


Remember that this nation is your people. The Lord replied, "***My presence will go with you, ...***

PROPHECY	FULFILLMENT
Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel (Isaiah 7:14)	BORN OF A VIRGIN After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 1:18)
Out of you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, shall come forth the One to be Ruler in Israel (Micah 5:2)	BORN IN BETHLEHEM Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea (Matthew 2:1)
The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding (Isaiah 11:2)	FAMED FOR WISDOM Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men (Luke 2:52)
He had done no violence, nor was any deceit in His mouth (Isaiah 52:6)	LIVED A SINLESS LIFE Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth (1 Peter 2:22)
Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. The lame shall leap like a deer (Isaiah 35:5-6)	HEALED THE NEEDY The blind saw and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear (Matthew 11:3)
The Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor (Isaiah 61:1)	PREACHED GOOD NEWS The poor have the gospel preached to them (Matthew 11:5)
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey (Zechariah 9:9)	ENTERED JERUSALEM IN TRUMPET They brought the colt to Jesus, and He sat on it... Then those who followed, cried, saying, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Mark 11:7-9)

PROPHECIES ABOUT CHRIST'S DEATH AND RESURRECTION

PROPHECY	FULFILLMENT
My own familiar friend in whom I trusted has shed up his back against me (Psalm 41:9)	BETRAYED BY A FRIEND Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went to the chief priests to betray Him (Mark 14:10)
They weighed out for my ransom thirty pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:12)	SOLD FOR THIRTY PIECES OF SILVER And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver (Matthew 26:15)
He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth (Isaiah 53:7)	SILENT WHEN ACCUSED He said, "See how many things they testify against You!" But Jesus still answered nothing (Mark 15:4-5)
I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard. I did not hide My face from shame and spitting (Isaiah 50:6)	BATEN AND SPAT UPON Then some began to spit on Him, and the others struck Him with the palms of their hands (Mark 14:65)
He was numbered with the transgressors (Isaiah 53:12)	CRUCIFIED WITH SINNERS With Him they also crucified two robbers (Mark 15:27)
They will look on Me whom they pierced (Zechariah 12:10)	HIS SIDE PIERCED But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear (John 19:34)
He made His grave with the rich at His death (Isaiah 53:9)	BURIED WITH THE RICH A rich man from Bethany, named Joseph, asked for the body of Jesus. Then Joseph laid it in his own new tomb (Matthew 27:57-60)
You will not leave my soul in Sheol, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption (Psalm 16:10)	ROSE FROM THE DEAD The angel said to them, "You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen!" (Mark 16:6)
You have ascended on high (Psalm 68:18)	ASCENDED INTO HEAVEN He was received up into heaven (Mark 16:19)
The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand" (Psalm 110:1)	EXALTED AT GOD'S RIGHT HAND Jesus Christ has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God (1 Peter 3:22)



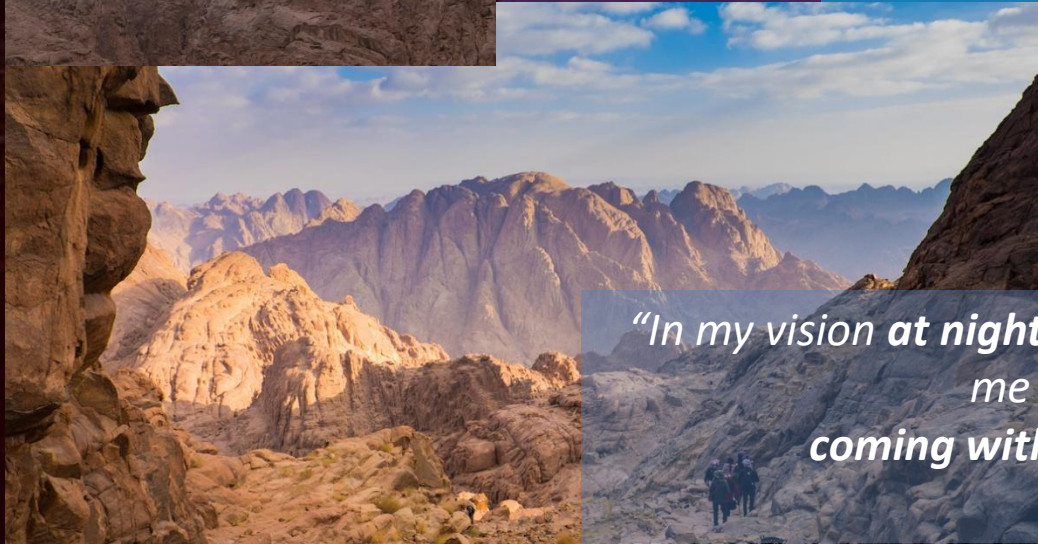
