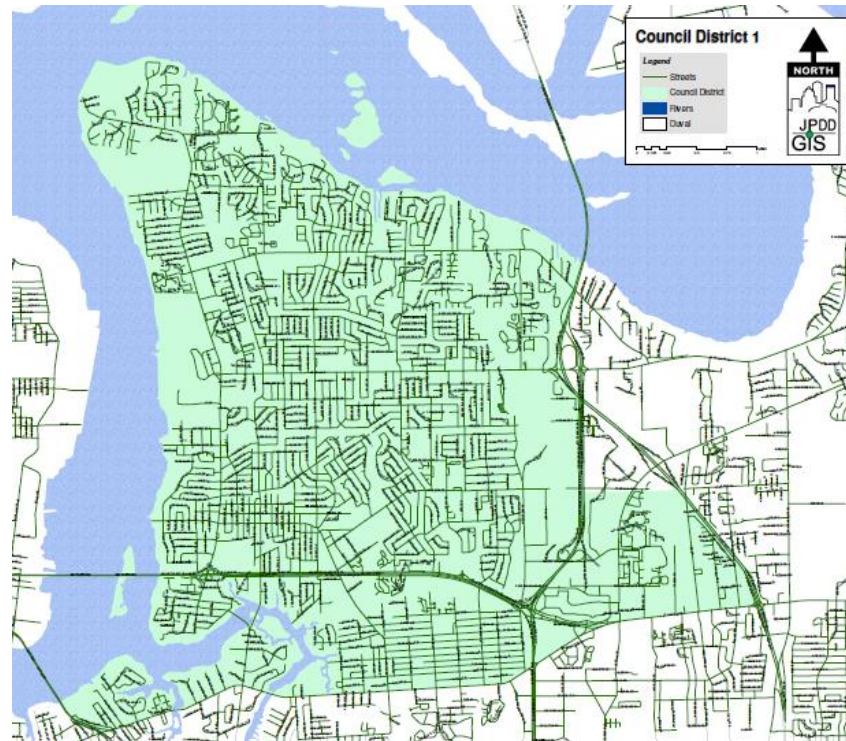

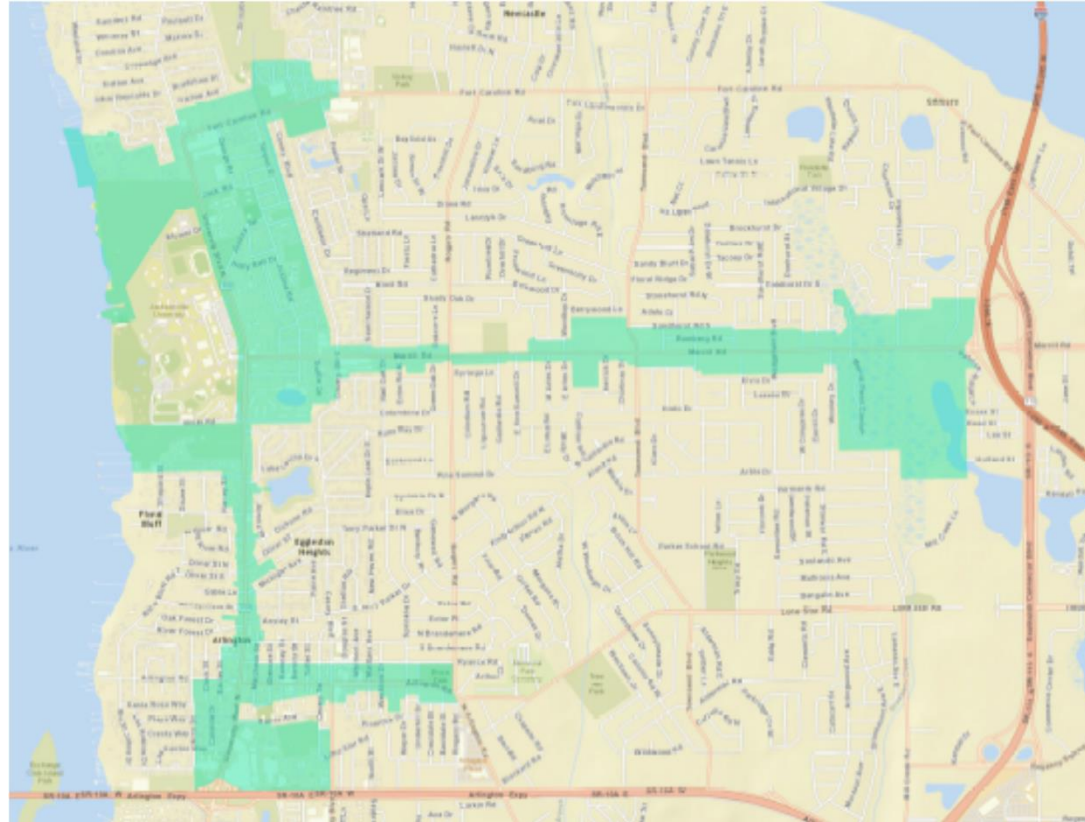

- Share your story... give witness to the Gospel in deed AND word, seek personal salvation and cultural transformation



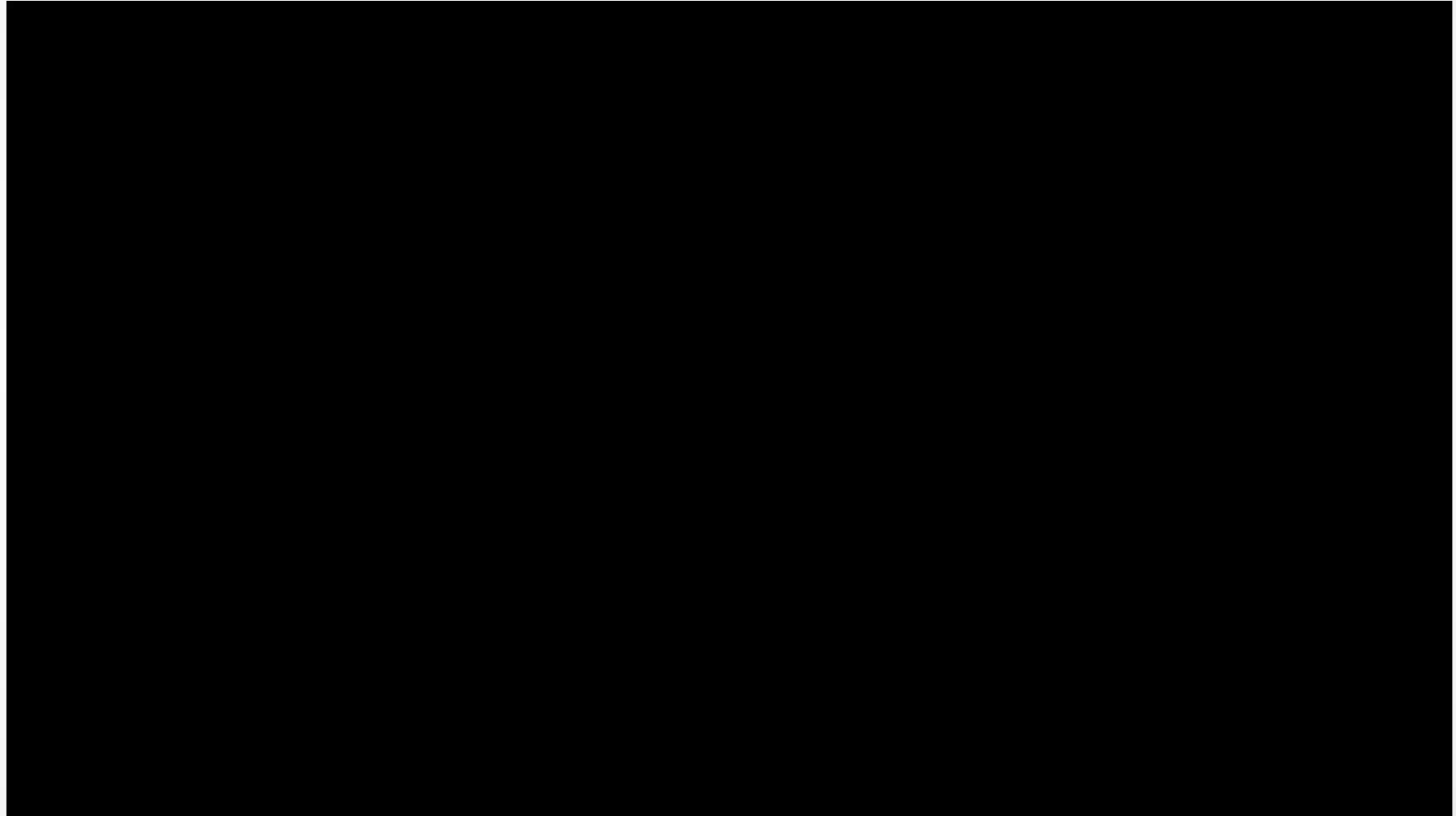
Why not add your street to the map? Join a movement of modern day disciples of Jesus Christ who are regularly walking their own streets while talking to God about their neighbors.


