

Dear Partners,

Most of you partners are fully aware of "*MERCY IN ACTION'S*" (*MIA*) 24-year ministry to street children in the Kenyan slum known as "Mathare Valley". This slum has over 600,000 adults and children surviving in abject poverty with no earthly hope or future. The street children Ruby met there in 1996 was the beginning of the ministry project now known as the "Mathare Child Development Centre" (MCDC). Over the years, *MIA* along with you partners, have seen this ministry grow to include up to 850 street kids being supplied with school uniforms, daily food, medical attention and a PK-12th grade Kenya accredited education. In addition to all this, live-in dormitory rooms are provided for up to 95 very high risk children and, its all done under the banner of "Jesus is Lord".

In 2022 the Kenya government issued directives to all schools designating grades 7-8-9 to be known as "Jr. High" grades, and as such, the 85 or so MCDC students in these grades would have to be supplied with 1) new different color uniforms 2) newly revised text books 3) new science and music rooms 4) student lockers. We estimate the total costs for all these special government requirements to be about \$20,000 to \$25,000.

Thank you, thank you to all of you partners who have already given to help fund these new government requirements.






Shown above are new uniforms purchased, in the past, for kids who have out-grown the ones they currently have, or for new students just enrolled at MCDC for the first time.

Regardless of a child's age, new uniforms cost about \$75 not including shoes. You give these kids good nourishing food and they out grow their clothes pretty fast. Just think about 800 plus kids and how often new uniforms and shoes need to be purchased.



It's always an exciting time when you get new clothes and then get to go and put them on! Lots of smiles! All get shirts and sweaters, the boys get pants and the girls skirts.



Older high school kids are no exception. Their uniforms are dark blue with white shirts. The older girls all like white socks. Reminds me of the 1950's.





MAASAI BUSH MINISTRY
