Magnet After-School Study Hall

We have a new opportunity for you – starting Monday, March 23, 2015. Magnet students who want to stay after school to make up a test or lesson, or stay for ELP on Wednesday or Thursday, or stay for a club meeting, will now have a place to go under supervision until 5:30pm – Monday through Friday. For example: if your student stays for ELP on Wednesday, they are to leave the campus when ELP ends at 4:00pm. What if their parent can't pick them up until 5:00pm? Where do they go between 4 and 5pm?

Our new After School Study Hall will take care of that problem. At 4pm, the

student can go to one of the two Study Hall classrooms. The Study Hall teachers are being paid from 3:15-5:30pm through a district grant, so there will be no cost to the magnet families who utilize this service at Middleton. A Study Hall application must be completed and turned in, however, to participate. The application and the location of the Study Hall rooms are on Edsby, so you can download from there. Please read and sign the application, which includes the program's policies.
