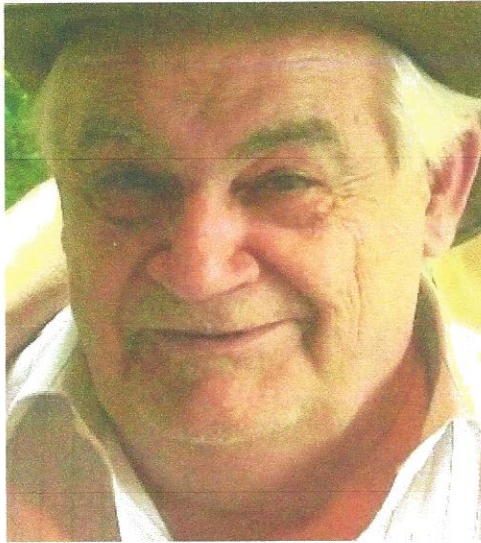


ACE CHANEY
