>> Tracie Rankin discussed the Spaghetti Supper, which is scheduled for Jan. 10 (CHS vs. MHS game). Rankin ordered the tickets this week and completed paperwork for the health department. She plans on having athletes sell tickets Thanksgiving through just before Christmas break.

>> Debbie Keefe created online sign-up sheets for the concession stand at all winter-season sport games. She also created an online sign-up sheet for Board members. She will work with Carolyn Carcasi (parent liaison) on

getting the links to coaches for distribution to all winter-athlete parents. Keefe will also email the Board sign-up sheet via email.

>> Carolyn Carcasi will attend upcoming winter sports parent meetings (with the exception of wrestling) to encourage volunteering at the concession stand, to distribute TBC membership forms and to answer questions/reach out on behalf of the Booster Club. Carcasi also will coordinate the concession stand sign-ups with coaches.

>> Sherwood mentioned possible candidates for the golf outing honoree.

>> The remainder of the meeting was spent discussing the upcoming Red and Gold Bash. Board members turned in donations and gave updates on potential/secured donations to Bash chair Molly Bickford. As it currently stands, the Bash committee will be able to begin decorating at the Brick House on Friday afternoon. Set-up will begin around 4 p.m.
