

June Block of the Month: Log Cabin

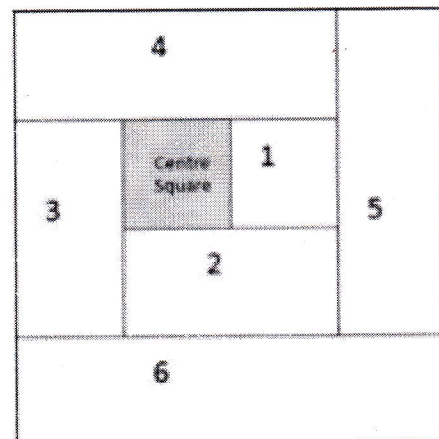
Block finishes at 12" (unfinished at 12 1/2").

Materials:

- 1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square of color 1
- 1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square and 1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" square of color 2
- 1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" square and 1 - 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" of color 3
- 1 - 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" square and 1 - 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" square of color 4

Construction:

Block is sewn in a spiral pattern. Start by sewing 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square of color 1 (Centre Square) to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square of color 2(#1). Always work in one direction. Sew 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip of color 2 to the side of first section(#2). *Measure block at this stage. It should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"*. Rotate and sew 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip of color 3 to the next side(#3). Continuing to rotate, sew 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip of color 3(#4), 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip(#5), and 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" strip of color 4(#6). Press seams flat. *Finished block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"*.



Remember your 1/4" seam allowance.

You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
