M101A1 105 Howitzer Towed Artillery Piece



After almost 8 years of being on the military's waiting list, The Village of Sheridan was awarded a M101A1 Howitzer Towed Artillery Piece for display in our Sheridan Veterans Memorial by the U.S. Army.

This artillery piece was developed in 1941 and used by U.S. Forces in WWII, Korean War, and Vietnam War.

During the planning stages of The Sheridan Veterans Memorial in 2006, there was room set aside in the East end for a military display piece. Today, that empty space is filled with a very important tool of honor that our veterans used to defend themselves and The United States of America!

SNOW ROUTES



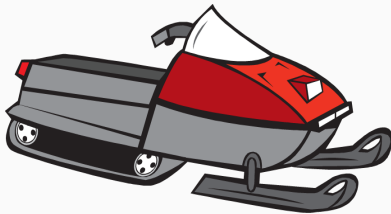
The Village snow routes are as follows:

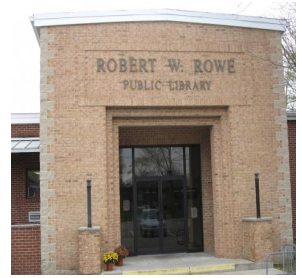
