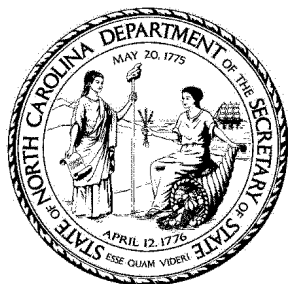

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

(Name of Corporation)

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

1. The name of the corporation is SOUTH POINT HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS
ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be Perpetual
(May be perpetual or for a limited period)

3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- To Raise Funds for the promotion of the South Point High School Band.
- To provide financial assistance toward the purchase cost, maintenance cost and care of band uniforms, instruments, music, travel, and miscellaneous equipment for the South Point High School Band.
- To provide chaperons and transportation service for the South Point High School Band.

4. The corporation is to have the following class or classes of members: (If there are to be no members, so state.) Individual Members & Organizations Members

5. Directors of the corporation shall be elected in the following manner: Directors shall be the Officers as elected by the Association, the South Point Band Director, the immediate Past President of the Association and One member appointed at large by the President of the Association.

9. In addition to the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of North Carolina, the corporation shall have full power and authority to

10. * In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.
