P.E. kit must be worn for all P.E. and games / lessons.

In the summer months when it is sunny, children are encouraged to wear sun hats suitable for school.

School Bags

Children need an envelope/Velcro type book bag (which are available to purchase from the office) to store their reading book and planner in the classroom. Any other bags need to be hung up in the cloakroom. As space is very limited please keep these as small as possible - drawstring type P.E. bags are ideal.

Hairstyles

Long hair should be tied back. We do not allow shaved sections of hair.

Footwear

Sensible footwear should be worn in school to maintain standards of health and safety.

Jewellery

Only watches, stud earrings and religious items may be worn for school. If you are planning to have your child's ears pierced please do this at the start of the summer holiday. All earrings must be removed for swimming and P.E.

Personal Belongings

Whilst all reasonable care will be taken of the children's personal property, neither the school nor Local Authority can take responsibility for any loss or damage. Children should not bring valuable items to school as we cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to such items.

Parents are asked to mark all their child's clothing and other belongings with their name.
