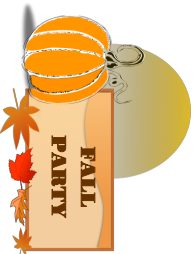

## JACK'S CORNER

### “WATER, A SOURCE OF SAVING”

Have you ever thought about the fact that God used water, to save people, both physically and spiritually?

- (1) Noah—God sent a flood to destroy the entire world because of their wickedness (Gen. 6:3), yet He saved Noah and his family. Noah built the ark at God's instruction. This floating vessel was their means of safety during the flood. Peter wrote: "...in the days of Noah, eight souls were saved through water" (1 Pet 3:20).
- (2) The Israelites, as they came to the Red Sea, were rescued from the Egyptians when God opened the sea and allowed them to cross on dry ground (Ex. 14:21-22, 30). The apostle Paul referred to this incident. He said, "...our fathers were...baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea" (1 Cor. 10:1-4).

- (3) Naaman, a great commander, had contracted the deadly disease of leprosy. Elisha the prophet sent word for him to dip 7 times in the Jordan River and he would be cleansed. Naaman obeyed and it was so (2 Kings 5:1, 14-15).

- (4) Mankind today has been given the means to be a part of the spiritual kingdom, the church. He has been instructed to complete his obedience through water. John 3:3-5 stresses the fact that unless one is born of the water and the Spirit, they cannot enter the kingdom of God. The following passages also teach the necessity of water in God's plan: Mk. 16:15-16; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Rom. 6:3-6; Gal. 3:26-27; 1 Pet. 3:21).

Notice in all the above instances that the people had to obey God. As a result of their obedience, they were saved. Today some think it unnecessary to obey the command of baptism. Is it so strange that God chose water as a means for us to be saved by contacting the blood of Jesus during the burial of our old man? If God chooses this means, we can choose no other.
