Reaching Youth, Young Adults and Any Demographic Group

Last year a team of researchers at the Fuller Youth Institute at Fuller Theological Seminary announced the results of a four-year study of US churches that are effectively reaching young people in their teens and their twenties. They examined 250 congregations from around the country and from a variety of denominational backgrounds and a variety of ethnic backgrounds. Part of the motivation for the study was the recognition that although young adults aged 18-29 make up 22% of the adult US population, they represent less than 10% of churchgoers.

A long list of qualities that the researchers originally expected would characterize churches who were effectively reaching people turned out not to be so important. The researchers noted these eight qualities as "things your church doesn't need." They were: 1) A trendy location; 2) a specific denomination, 3) a "culturally relevant" pastoral teaching style, including pastors' attire, 4) a precise size, 5) an exact age, 6) a big budget, 7) contemporary worship, 8) a big, modern building.

Here are some of the characteristics that they found in churches that were reaching young people: "This was an inescapable theme across the many churches we studied: They want to be the best possible neighbors within their city. These churches were creatively involved in being good neighbors, and they involved young people in the process."

Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth. 1 John 3:18

They also found that these churches involve young people throughout the other ministries of the church. They even let them have a part in decision-making. "When these congregations think about budget, strategy, worship planning, programming, community life, theology, and all other aspects of Christian life together, they think about young people."

Perhaps more than anything else, the researchers found that churches effective at reaching youth had people who loved them. Typical of this was a response that they found at Immanuel Church of the Nazarene in Lansdale, PA. When asked to share what they love about their congregation, a 22-year-old spoke for a group of 20-somethings and said simply "Bill Wallace." Other heads nodded. Whether he is attending this group's Bible study, or greeting them in the hallway, or attending a kids' basketball game, he made it his mission to make sure that young people know that he cares. Bill Wallace is 76 years old.

My takeaway is that the key factor in reaching any demographic group, in reaching any community, in impacting any neighborhood is loving people with Christ like love. May that begin with each of us. (*Christianity Today*, September 2016)


MEN'S BREAKFAST
