ARRL In Action: What Have We Been Up To Lately?

The ARRL Amateur Radio Legal Defense and Assistance Committee has voted to contribute \$5000 toward the costs of a <u>lawsuit</u> against the City of Palmdale, California. The city has proposed a highly restrictive antenna ordinance.

With snow and ice impacting all parts of the Pacific Northwest in late December, local ARES® groups <u>assisted</u> served agencies, including local Emergency Operations Centers.

In Nevada, a major winter storm brought hurricane force winds that damaged sensitive electronic weather equipment. SKYWARN spotters <u>stepped in</u> to provide real-time weather data via Amateur Radio.

In New England, ARES units <u>responded</u> in the wake of a severe ice storm that knocked out power to nearly 400,000 households in Massachusetts alone.

Those who submitted a November Sweepstakes log with more than 100 contacts <u>qualify</u> for a Sweepstakes Participation pin, and if you submitted a log with a Clean Sweep, you qualify for a Clean Sweep coffee mug.

The House Committee on Energy and Commerce -the congressional committee that oversees the Federal Communications Commission -- <u>released</u> a majority staff report that confirms a number of allegations against FCC Chairman Kevin Martin.
